National Joblink (NJL) is a community-based not-for-profit registered training organisation providing a broad range of training & assessment services to businesses & job seekers throughout Tasmania, Queensland, South Australia, New South Wales & the Northern Territory.

NJL is the provider of the Transition to Work service for young people (aged 15-24 years) in:

- North & North West Tasmania
- Rockhampton & Berserker
- Gladstone

What we will provide to you:

- A single point of contact to ensure consistency.
- Shortlisting job seekers: pre-screening resumes and interviews so you can select from a well-prepared pool of applicants.
- On site visits – we will come to you to save you time.
- Wage subsidies can be offered for Indigenous or long-term unemployed young people to assist with the costs of their training.
- Information and contacts on apprenticeships and traineeships.
- Cultural competency – we assist employers to understand the cultural differences between young people and the broader workforce, how to effectively communicate with and motivate young employees.
- Work experience support including induction, workplace safety education and full insurance coverage.
- Post-placement support for up to 6 months, designed to the needs of your employee and business.
